The Church

This is a traditional church building with modern additions and a modernised sanctuary with carpets and chairs rather than fixed pews. The sanctuary is versatile and simple in style.

The altar furniture is simple and modern, with a font that is placed in a prominent position for baptism ceremonies.



There is modern art and there are symbols to notice, in particular the way that crosses have been incorporated into the design of new windows and wherever an opportunity arises. Note, too, the row of fishes on glass doors and the cross subtly shown in a colourful ceramic design at the top of the stairs.

Modern meeting rooms are used by groups from the church and community, with many activities and meetings taking place each month.



Questions to ask in this church

- On the website (above), it says 'where Christian love meets Community need'. What do you think this means? What might this look like?
- How does the art in this church reflect the beliefs of the people who worship here?
- Does the outside of the church match the inside in style?
- How many crosses can you see around the building? (some are quite hard to spot)
- What does the fish symbolise in the Christian faith?
