Dr Darren Chetty is a Lecturer at UCL, having previously taught in primary schools for over twenty years. He continues to work with schools on policy, curriculum and pedagogy and has published academic work on racism, dialogue, children's literature and hip-hop culture. He is a contributor to the bestselling book, The Good Immigrant, edited by Nikesh Shukla, and wrote, with Karen Sands O'Connor, Beyond the Secret Garden: Racially Minoritised People in British Children's Books.

Using real-life classroom scenarios, Darren will explore how teachers can become confident in identifying 'the hidden curriculum' and develop their practice to meet the challenge of addressing gaps in knowledge and understanding in relation to the history of racism.
