Supporting children with trauma & insecure attachments at school

For school professionals

Children who have faced neglect, abuse or other adverse experiences in early childhood often fail to form secure attachments with adults & peers. As a result, they can find settling at school & learning really difficult. They will often exhibit a variety of behaviours which staff may find challenging including physical & emotional dysregulation, masking, dissociation, emotion-based demand avoidance.

This training will be delivered over 2 sessions & will go through the impact of trauma & insecure attachments on children & strategies to support them to feel safe, reduce pre-occupation, regulate emotions & focus on engagement & academic learning.
